

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
Skeleton level and pattern


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- combination (complexity)
- pax on board at key points (sharp cutoffs)
- (peak) pax kilometre (few long routes)
- (peak) pax boarding (short trips)

Possible outputs

Economic project

- evaluation framework and total expenditure
- rating schedule
- financial assistance rate
- incentives (including competitive market issues)
- consistency with infrastructure
- prediction of impacts





Economic project: evaluation framework

Limited budget: how to ration?

Top down = target expenditure level - how to update?


Bottom up = evaluated expenditure level - how to achieve suitable level?

Explore ways to meet the two






Level adjusted as all day base rate




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Level adjusted as congestion peak rate

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Key features: as described to PTAG

Payment method: 'bums on seats'

• issues - should all services be patronage funded?

Partial evaluation: external benefits/PT cut-off

- how should a funding cut-off be included and what should it be?
- **Output basis: commercial+contracted (total system)**
 - what if there is no funding gap?

Risk

• how to reflect lower risk of funding outputs?

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Output rate schedule: varies with congestion

- one rate for all passengers, or two-tier rate for existing and new passengers?
- should it vary by other factors?

Output rate level: aim at government target

- what is the current base?
- what is fair allocation between regions · Dunedin vs Wellington issue
- FAR: based on total quantity of expenditure
 - how to reward reinvestment?



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FAR is a mechanism to...

- equitably divide benefits to each party
- efficiently extend the scarcest funds
- incentivise RCs to manage expenditure increases
- align incentives
- target' funds to regions with a greaterneed
