
We support the principal of moving from cash accounting to accrual accounting.

WHOLESALE WATER LEVY

Thank you for your letter dated 21 December 2000 relating to proposed changes to the way wholesale water charges are allocated to the four Cities in the region. I apologise for the delay in replying.

Hutt City Council have operated accrual accounting practises with the wholesale water charges over many years. The proposal by the Wellington Regional Council to move to similar accrual accounting practises will undoubtedly improve the presentation and understanding of the wholesale Levy reports.

The proposal to invoice the Cities one twelfth of the adjustment from the previous year payable on a monthly basis is however considered to be complicated. Hutt City Council would prefer to receive a single invoice in June for the previous years adjustment which would be paid and accrued in a single transaction back to that year.
