## **Regional Council Input into District Planning**

## 1. Purpose

To inform the Committee of Regional Council input into the statutory resource management processes of territorial authorities in the Wairarapa.

## 2. Applications

### 2.1 Carterton District Council

Notified Applications Cherry C	Action 12 lot subdivision, Rexwood Street, Carterton. Made a submission reiterating pre-application comments about need to consult CDC on surface flooding issues, and noted need for WRC consent for diverting or crossing the drain.
<u>Non-notified</u> Potts W & McKenzie H	Action 2 lot subdivision, Eringa Road, Longbush. Supported proposed erosion mitigation measures and plantings.
Quinn R	3 lot subdivision, Hodders Road, Carterton. Noted flooding risk from Waiohine River and Mangatarere Stream and recommended care in siting buildings and wastewater disposal. Supported amalgamation condition.
Oldfield Aggregates Ltd	Landuse consent to extract gravel from the land adjoining the Waingawa River. Site visit undertaken. Received further information from applicant. Recommended conditions on landuse

Owen D	<ul><li>consent in order to protect groundwater from interception during excavation. Also commented on minimising potential dust effects, the relocation of the water race, and future use of the site.</li><li>2 lot subdivision, Admiral Road, Gladstone. No comments necessary.</li></ul>

<u>Notified</u> Kiddie C	Action 7 lot subdivision, Jetty Road, Castlepoint. Supported connection to sewerage and possible stormwater systems.
Cashmere Partnership	33 lot subdivision Opaki Road/SH 2, Masterton. In progress.
<u>Non-notified</u> Carroll & Cameron	Action 2 lot subdivision, Black Rock Road, Masterton. Noted flooding risk on lower terrace and advocated for esplanade strip.
Mills M	3 lot subdivision, Lees Pakaraka Road, Masterton. Supported the recommendations and restrictions for wastewater disposal made in application.
Tomlinson & Cheetham	4 lot subdivision, Guthrie Crescent, Castlepoint. Supported connection to sewerage and stormwater systems. Noted erosion potential and supported proposed restrictions. More information provided on potential building sites for Lot 3. Supported additional restrictions in engineers report.

<u>Notified Consents</u> Genesis Power Ltd	<u>Action</u> Application to extend Haunui wind farm. Regional Council consulted at pre-application stage. Made submission reiterating concerns about surface water flows and erosion potential. Draft conditions received, supported modified conditions to mitigate our concerns. Consent granted.
Tyer D	Jointly notified consent with Regional Council to construct and operate crayfish holding tanks, Te Oroi, Tora. Made submission supporting proposed measures to mitigate visual effects on coastal environment and sought clarification that public access along coastal strip would not be impeded.
