Urban Rail Services Contract between The Wellington Regional Council ("WRC") and Tranz Rail Ltd (formerly New Zealand Rail Ltd) dated 24 April 1995 as amended from time to time (the "Agreement").

I refer to your discussion with Ross Hayward relating to the restructuring of Tranz Rail Limited. As part of this process, all of the assets and liabilities of Tranz Rail Ltd are being transferred to wholly owned subsidiaries for each area of the business.
