Air Discharge Permit Application to Discharge Contaminants to Air from the Operation of a Hot Dip Galvanising Process and Associated Activities

1. Purpose

To report to the Committee on the resource consent application from New Zealand Galvanising Limited, received under the Resource Management Act 1991 (the Act).

2. Background

3. Negotiation of Consent Conditions

Both the applicant and submitters have agreed to the recommended conditions. I am satisfied that the conditions are sufficient to avoid, remedy or mitigate the effects of the discharge of contaminants to air from the operation of a hot-dip galvanising process and associated activities.
