- (5) That the management of Cathedral Bells, Banana Passionfruit, Climbing Asparagus, and Wild Ginger in Wellington City should be undertaken in accordance with the standard rules for these pest plants under the Regional Pest Management Strategy 2002-2022.
 - (a) Occupiers in Wellington City shall destroy all Old Man's Beard (Clematis vitalba) plants within 10 metres of their boundary following a complaint to the Council by an adjoining occupier whose land, within 10 metres of the boundary, is clear or being cleared of Old Man's Beard. A breach of this rule will create an offence under Section 154(r) of the Act.
