## USING YOUR TOTAL MOBILITY VOUCHERS

- You are responsible for the information provided on your Total Mobility Vouchers
- Fill out the "From" and "To" lines on the vouchers with an address or street name and provide full information about the metre fare charged and the half fare you have paid. The taxi driver may assist you with this if necessary but it is your responsibility.
- DO NOT sign any voucher until you have checked the information on it is correct.
- You may have a care-giver or friends with you when you travel using Total Mobility, but the purpose of the trip must be for yourself. Do not pass vouchers on to family or friends they are for your use only.
- We recommend that for your own safety you call the office dispatch service of the taxi company you have chosen to arrange for a taxi. Do not call an individual taxi driver.
- Please Note : The staff of Greater Wellington audits every Total Mobility voucher used in the region each month.
- Do not be tempted to misuse the Total Mobility scheme. Suspected abuse of the scheme may result in immediate suspension and removal from the scheme, police investigation and possible prosecution.
