(2)	Agrees to the proposals for access for 2003/04 in the Orongorongo Catchment as follows:
	<ul> <li>- 6 tours of 15 people</li> <li>- guiding ratios of 2:15 (one of the guides must be a staff member).</li> </ul>
(3)	Agrees that a public 'roar hunt' continue to operate through a ballot system.
(4)	That during the review of access next year, officers investigate the possibility of operating on a commercial or franchise basis.
