That Council:

- (1) Agree to the proposals for access for 2003/04 in the Wainuiomata Catchment as follows:
 - trips of 60 people
 - guiding ratios of 1:15
 - six 'group tours' and six 'individuals tours'
- (2) Agree to the proposals for access for 2003/04 in the Orongorongo Catchment as follows:
 - 6 tours of 15 people
 - guiding ratios of 2:15 (one of the guides must be a staff member).
- (3) Agree that a public 'roar hunt' continue to operate through a ballot system
- (4) That during the review of access next year, officers investigate the possibility of operating on a commercial or franchise basis.

Next Review

The principles relating to public access to water supply catchments, as set out in Report 00.412 *Public Access to Wainuiomata and Orongorongo Water Supply Catchment,* approved by Utility Services on 12 June 2000, will be used by officers when access arrangements are next reviewed including the options of commercial or franchised access which are now part of the current Water Catchment Management Plan.
