Anstis, S	4 lot subdivision, Chester Road. Comments made in relation to wastewater disposal, and odour issues in association with the neighbouring pig farm.
Arcus, B S	4 lot subdivision and boundary adjustment, Udys and Waitangi Road. No comments.
Pendalton Limited	3 lot subdivision, Carters Line. No comments.
Perham, W J & A G	2 lot subdivision, Riversdale Road. Noted that the site is within the Parkvale groundwater moratorium.
Regan, T	2 lot subdivision, Mt Holdsworth Road. Further information requested on wastewater disposal, stormwater management, roading and tracking, and potential GW consent requirements.
