## a) <u>Rates Remission on Flood Affected Properties</u> (FN70-02)

#### **RESOLVED**:

#### Minute No. C 040417

"That Council:

- (i) approves the applications for residential rates remissions on flood affected *properties between 16 February and 31 August 2004 totalling* \$10,552.84, as listed in Appendix 1 to the **report**;
- (ii) approves the applications for business rates remissions on flood affected properties between 16 February and 31 August 2004 totalling \$1,430.94, as listed in Appendix 2 to the report;
- (iii) delegates authority to the General Manager Finance and the Treasurer to allowfurther rates remissions on the properties listed in Appendices 1 and 2 up until the owners return to their homes or resume full use of the properties or until 28 February 2005, whichever is the earlier;
- (iv) approaches the Greater Wellington Regional Council with a request to give favourable consideration to remitting its rates on these same properties, for the same period of time;
- (v) approves the applications for residential rates remissions on the properties affected by a landslip on 18 August 2004, as listed in Appendix 2 to the report, and delegates authority to the General Manager Finance and the Treasurer to allow further remissions on these twoproperties until they are able to be re-occupied, or until 30 June 2005, whichever is the earlier, and agrees that applications from other similarly affected property owners who wish to apply for rates remissions will also be addressed under this delegation; and
- (vi) agrees that these matters will be reviewed at the end of the respective delegation periods."
