Requested an upgrade of the existing wastewater system and compliance with the Discharges to Land Plan for the new system. Advised of potential for soil erosion and supported vegetation protection.
Stoney Ltd	9 Lot subdivision, Martins Rd, Martinborough. Comments made regarding the one in 50 year flood hazard zone and also potential flooding of additional areas in some lots. Recommended setbacks from terrace edges and asked South Wairarapa District Council to be certain each site could contain a dwelling and effluent system given the site constraints.
