3. Comment

At the end of March the Division's funding position was \$109,000 within budget. Total revenue was \$1,783,000 below budget and total operating expenditure was \$1,964,000 below budget. Capital expenditure at March was \$19,000 within budget.

Significant components of this favourable variance are as follows:

(1) Land & River Operations \$464,000 Unfavourable

River Management was \$406,000 unfavourable because of numerous flood damage repair works.

(2) Biosecurity \$284,000 Favourable

Net savings of \$218,000 for Bovine Tb control and \$140,000 for Pest Plant control. Pest Animal expenditure was \$109,000 over budget, relating to KNE operations and the Monitoring & Investigations Section.

(3) Planning & Resources \$160,000 Favourable

Contract expenditure for Resource Investigations was \$140,000 favourable due to timing. Consent processing revenue was \$91,000 below budget due to reduced activity. The Department's personnel costs were \$58,500 under budget because of delays in replacing staff.

(4) BioWorks \$109,000 Favourable

Due to operational savings and the timing of vehicle acquisitions.
