## LC 182 Hearing of Public Submissions

#### Resolved

- All 72 written submissions were considered.
- Officers were asked to make full and forthright responses to the submissions. The draft replies are to be submitted to the Chairman for approval and signing.
- Submission 26, Julie Martin Officers to discuss the Martin's concerns regards public access along Hutt City Council's coast road.

#### LC 183 **Deliberation**

#### **Recommendations:**

- **Duck shooting** permitted under DOC conditions.
- **Dogs** permitted with specific restrictions. Permitted in Lakes Block under control of duck shooter, and in the mainland island under control.
- **Hunting** allowed if permit issued to individual hunters. Number of permits to be determined by GW Park Rangers. Not permitted on west-facing slopes.
- **Mountain biking** permitted on Main and Rata ridge tracks in the north block.
- **Camping** permitted, except in picnic area at Gollans Creek. Recommended installing another toilet and tables in the latter area.
- **Hang gliding** permitted.
- **Cultural/heritage** *status quo* (best standard practise) to be accepted.
  - Problem of access along coast road to be left for Hutt City to resolve.
  - Honorary forest rangers to be recognised as a separate group, and added to the "Partnerships in the Park" section.
  - Advocacy for issues outside the park (1.17, p. 13) to be retained. First sentence to be retained, second sentence to be removed.
  - Reserve status of Lakes Block to remain.
  - Track behind Waiuiomata Golf Club to remain.
  - *status quo* to be accepted for fire risk policy in Lakes Block. Fire to be permitted for vegetation management if necessary.
  - *status quo* to be accepted for spreading of burial ashes, but policy to be reviewed.
  - Box culvert at Lake Kohangatera to remain.
  - Possible name change to "Pencarrow Park" to be discussed with local iwi.
  - Concern expressed at tone of public meetings with stakeholders. Requested that further consultation to be held

On 27 November the meeting was adjourned from 10.38 am to 10.50 am for morning tea, 12.03 pm - 12.49 pm for lunch, from 2.22 pm to 2.48 pm for afternoon tea, and at 3.46 for the day. Councillor Glensor left the meeting at 1.03 pm.
