- Negotiations have commenced with Stagecoach on the new trolley bus contract
- Cabinet has clarified that Land Transport New Zealand may use part of the "C2" funding to contribute to Greater Wellington Regional Council's local share for the capital cost of rail passenger transport projects for the Wellington Western Corridor
