Implementation of passenger transport activities within the proposed Regional Transport Programme is an ongoing activity for GW as lead agency. This report covers the first 15 months of the 10-year programme. Planned progress is therefore assigned a total of 12.5%. Where passenger transport activities have met delivery expectations, 12.5% actual implementation has been assigned.
