### 3.1 Financial report for the nine months ended 31 March 2009

The Chief Financial Officer gave an overview, commenting that the major variance in the operational result is due to the lower oil prices impacting on the payments to the bus operators.

There was discussion on revaluation of debt, the ownership of the trains and the split between controllable and non-controllable expenditure in Public Transport.
