3.4 Archaeological Workshop

Ara Tahi was advised of Greater Wellington's intention to develop an approach to including reference to archaeological sites in district plans. It was raised that the format of the forthcoming archaeological workshop as it stood was not conducive to discussion, and although Ara Tahi was eager to hear what the guest speakers would bring to the table, it would be better to facilitate dialogue for both sides to share ideas. It was also raised that the term "archaeological" was limiting due to its focus on the physical, and that "sites of significance" would give more coverage.
