# PE EW 1 Drainage from Tawaha Floodway, Lower Wairarapa Valley Development Scheme

# 3. Requests officers to:

- (a) Prepare the required resource consent applications to legalise the diversion of the Tawaha drainage into the Whakawiriwiri Stream via what is known as "Campbells cut", and to undertake further improvements to the stream on the basis of Option 4.
- (b) Ensure affected landowners, and other affected parties, have opportunity to consider and comment on a draft application document before lodging.
- (c) Seek the necessary entry approvals for the remaining Whakawiriwiri Stream upgrade work, once consents have been granted, with the aim of completing the work within 12 months of receiving the necessary entry approvals.
- 4. Notes that the estimated capital cost of implementing Option 4 is \$180,000. This cost will be provided for from the LWVDS approved capital upgrade expenditure programme for 2012/13.
- 5. Notes that the estimated cost to the LWVDS of the proposed maintenance contribution to the Whakawiriwiri Stream main channel from the lower Barton lagoon to Kahutara Road is estimated at \$1500 per annum, and can be funded from the existing LWVDS maintenance budget.
- 6. Requests officers to write to affected landowners advising of the Council's decision on this matter.
- 7. Requests officers to advise the LWVDS Advisory Committee of its decision and to keep members informed on progress with implementing the outcomes.
