Purpose

Background

- 2 A draft Letter of Expectation outlining the expectations of the Committee for WREDA is attached (refer **Attachment 1**).
- 3 WREDA was established in December 2014 from Positively Wellington Tourism, Positively Wellington Venues and Grow Wellington/Creative HQ. Following the arrival of the new WREDA Chief Executive it will also include Major Events from Wellington City Council (WCC).
- 4 The two shareholding councils have had discussions on this draft Letter and it is now for the Committee to consider the Letter and make such changes that they wish.
- 5 Following the agreement of the Committee the Letter will be sent to WREDA for consideration in their planning process. It is expected that all the matters raised in this Letter will be addressed in their final Statement of Intent.
