Emma Speight, Regional Relationships Lower North Island Director, NZTA, gave an oral report to the Committee on NZTA projects, including an update that the National Land Transport Programme is due for release on Friday 31 August 2018. She advised that under the Provincial Growth Fund the Wairarapa Councils may be able to get funding for transport projects but that such projects will still need to meet NZTA criteria. Emma spoke at Rail Safety Week and that NZTA is currently consulting on Traffic Control Management. The committee was also informed about upcoming changes to the road layouts of SH1 at Linden and McKay's crossing due to the construction of Transmission Gully and that there would be adjustments to speed limits in these areas.
